

Exhibition Proposals

Artists and Curators are encouraged to submit exhibition proposals to the Red Deer Museum + Art Gallery (MAG). Please note that the MAG will only review submissions from artists or curators who have completed their basic training (or equivalent); produced an independent body of work; had at least one prior public presentation of their work in a professional context; and maintained an independent practice for at least three years. In-complete proposals will not be accepted.

Submission Requirements

- 1. **Cover Letter**. This letter should contain an introduction, contact information and a brief summary of your exhibition proposal.
- 2. **Artist/Curator's Statement/Proposal**. The artist/curator's statement or proposal should indicate the media, technique, theme or context of the proposed exhibition. It should also address any specific technical, spatial or special requirements regarding the installation of the work or exhibition. Please limit to 1 2 pages.
- Current Curriculum Vitae. Include a current copy of you CV or resume, listing educational background and exhibition history. This should not exceed 2 pages.
- 4. **Images**. 10-15 images with corresponding list indicating title, medium, size, and dates. CD's and DVD's are accepted.
- 5. **Relevant Support Material**. If relevant, include a selection of support material, such as copies of recent reviews and publications showing the artwork or exhibition.

Note: All exhibition proposals are reviewed annually by a committee. Please ensure that your submission can easily be photocopied for review. Only those exhibition proposals under consideration will be contacted. The MAG will only return submissions that include a self-addressed envelope with sufficient postage.
